

The first volume of Islamic art and archaeology covering work published in the year 1954 was issued in 1956 and has received sympathetic reviews from Professor Mayer in BSOAS XXI, 1958, 1934 and Mr Yuri Borshchevskiy in Sovetskoe Vostokovedenie 1957, No. 6, 173-7. In addition to his general comments on the bibliography, Mr Borshchevskiy has added in his review the titles of a large number of Soviet works on Islamic art and archaeology, published in 1954. A few other titles of works published in that year which were omitted from the earlier volume have been included in the present one.

As before, the thanks of the compilers are due to those scholars and librarians who have assisted them by providing titles of books and articles which might otherwise have escaped their notice, in particular to the late Professor Mayer, whose recently announced death is a severe blow to all students of the subject, to Dr Ettinghausen, Dr Curiel, Dr Kurz, Mr Wheen and Mr Borshchevskiy.

It is regretted that circumstances have delayed for so long the appearance of the volume for 1955. Work has reached an advanced stage in the preparation of the 1956 volume and it is hoped that this may be published after a much shorter interval than that which occurred between the publication of the two first volumes.




