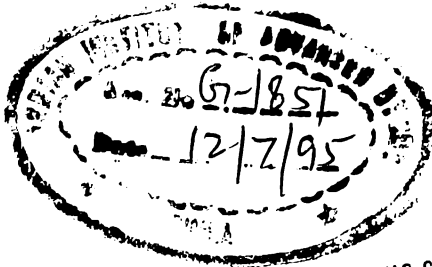

This number is dedicated to the memory of Sakharam Ganesh Deuskar (1869-1912) who devoted his life and wielded his pen for the cause of the Indian nation and made a distinct mark as a nationalist journalist and author of historical works in Bengali. It is intended to commemorate his birth Centenary as a People's Historian who ushered in a new approach to the study of history, in which life and conditions of the people are depicted vividly, instead of the wars and conquests of the rulers.

Sakharam, son of Ganesh Sadashiv, was born at Deoghar (then in Bengal Presidency) on 17 December 1869. He had his schooling there at the local school. Deoghar, it should be remembered, was then the bed of nascent revolutionary thought, with Rajnarayan Bose (maternal-grandfather of Sri Aurobindo) and Jogindra Nath Bose (Headmaster of the local school) as its exponents. Sakharam appears to have his initiation in nationalism there from them. After the death of his father, Sakharam joined the local school where he taught till he was discharged for writing an article in the *Hitavadi*, a weekly Bengali paper of note in Calcutta, against the misdeeds of the Magistrate, Mr. Hardy. Soon after, in 1897, he had to leave Deoghar for Calcutta, and joined the *Hitavadi* as a Proof-Reader there.

He was an accomplished writer in Bengali. None before him (and few after him) had the courage to write with boldness, facts and arguments to inspire the people to reach the goal against heavy odds. For this he had naturally to pay a heavy price in that period of imperialist rule.

He took initiative in organising the first Shivaji festival in Bengal in June 1902: and played an active part in the anti-Partition agitation in Bengal (in 1905-1908); and joined the "extremist" (nationalist) group of the Congress in Bengal in 1906.

After the death of Kaliprasana Kavyavisarad (4 July 1907) he became the editor of *Hitavadi*, from which he, however, resigned (1908) due to his difference of opinion with the management because of his extremist leanings. He then joined, as Professor of History, the newly established Bengal National College (which later developed into the Jadavpur University) but left the post in order to save the authorities of the College from embarrassment when his book *Deshar Katha* was proscribed by the then Government for its criticism of the British policy of exploitation (1910).

The outstanding characteristic of Sakharam was the fact that he did not stop with merely 'writing from a safe distance'. He was always in the fight and inside the battle-field with pen as his weapon and organisational activities for the freedom struggle as his duty and never retracing his step to safety or compromising his stand for any price. This was rare in those days (and even now) for a historian preaching what he believed to be true after examining all relevant facts and documents, and practising the same. His major field of activity still lay in writing the history of the country in a language and in a style intelligible to the people of the land.¹ He collected facts and data from different sources with diligence and care, and presented them in a way so as to arouse the nationalistic spirit of his readers and inspire them to break away the chain of foreign domination.

Sakharam Ganesh Deuskar, a Maharastrian by descent, rendered unique service to Bengali literature by his historical and economic writings²; and his style was clear and vigorous³. The Bengali people gratefully claimed him to be their own, 'a Bengali writer'.

Though Rabindranath Tagore, then a guiding spirit of the Swadeshi movement, did not agree with the ways⁴ advocated by Sakharam for achieving independence, he admitted that Sakharam's writings, esp. *Deshar Katha*,⁵ would be helpful in India's march towards independence.⁵

Sakharam passed away at Deoghar on 23 November 1912 at the age of 43, rather prematurely, worn out by a life of struggle.

Sakharam Ganesh Deuskar

Desher Katha by Pandit Sakharam Ganesh Deuskar has been proscribed and confiscated by the Government of two Bengals on the ground of its containing writings that are likely to create disaffection in the readers.

POLITICAL/NOTIFICATION

No. 2840 P.D.—The 22nd September 1910.—Whereas it appears to the Lieutenant Governor that a Bengali book entitled “*Desher Katha*” written and published by Sakharam Ganesh Deuskar, contains words of the nature described in section 4, sub-section (1), of the Indian Press Act (I of 1910), inasmuch as they have a tendency to excite disaffection towards His Majesty or the Government established by law in British India;

Now, therefore, in exercise of power conferred by Section 12, sub-section (1), of the said Act, the Lieutenant Governor hereby declares all copies of the said book forfeited to His Majesty.

Preface

In the following pages have been presented a catalogue of proscribed publications in Indian languages, deposited in the India Office Library and Records, London (IOLR). The catalogue is based on the list prepared in the IOLR. Dr. B.C. Bloomfield, the then Director of the Library, was kind enough to accord permission to use the list while preparing the present catalogue. Thanks are due to the authorities of IOLR, for the permission & assistance.

It is expected that the catalogue will be helpful to the scholars engaged in writing the history of freedom movement in India.

In spite of all precautions few inaccuracies have crept in the text, which, if brought to the notice of the editor, will be incorporated in the next edition of the bibliography with due acknowledgement.

Thanks are due to all those who made the compilation and publication of the work possible, espl. to Dr. B. C. Bloomfield, authorities & workers of the K. P. Bose Printing works (which has now been winded up), and others.

The IOLR is the oldest and also the largest, specialist oriental library in existence. Its foundation was laid, officially in 1801, by the Directors of the East India company. It has gathered to itself such precious possessions as the Tipoo Sultan manuscripts (part of which are in the possession of the Asiatic Society, Calcutta) and the Sir Philip Francis papers.

In the Bengal Despatches (vol. 32, pp. 930-39) there is a public letter dated the 25th May 1798, which (para 105-107) refers to the project of forming a collection of oriental mss, ; the prime mover of the project was perhaps Robert Orme. Charles Wilkins heard about it and offered his services, and on [1] January, 1799, he took charge of the Museum. When asked by the Court of Directors, he submitted his sketch of plan for an oriental Museum proposed to be established at the India

Office. Warren Hastings also recommended his idea. Ultimately Wilkins was appointed, on 18.02.1801, the Librarian of the Museum.

'Munificent donations there upon followed in from old servants of the company. After the demise of Wilkins (13-05-1836), Professor H. H. Wilson (b. 26.09.1786), took charge of the Library and other collections, in spite of opposition from some quarters.

The Indian Press and Registration of Books Act (Act XXV of 1867) which was passed in 1867, entitled the IOLR to receive one copy of every printed or lithographed book including *proscribed materials*, issued in India. Thus it became a valuable store house of Indian literature, with some lacunae 'by virtue of the discriminate selections of a succession of learned librarians.' It has now an oriental collection by over 28,000 mss. and 2,60,000 printed books and other materials,

The responsibility for this vast collections of the IOLR has now been transferred from the Foreign and Commonwealth Office to the British Library Board, by an announcement in the British House of Commons on 08 March 1982 and in the House of Lords on 01 April 1982. The Act came into effect on 01 April 1982.

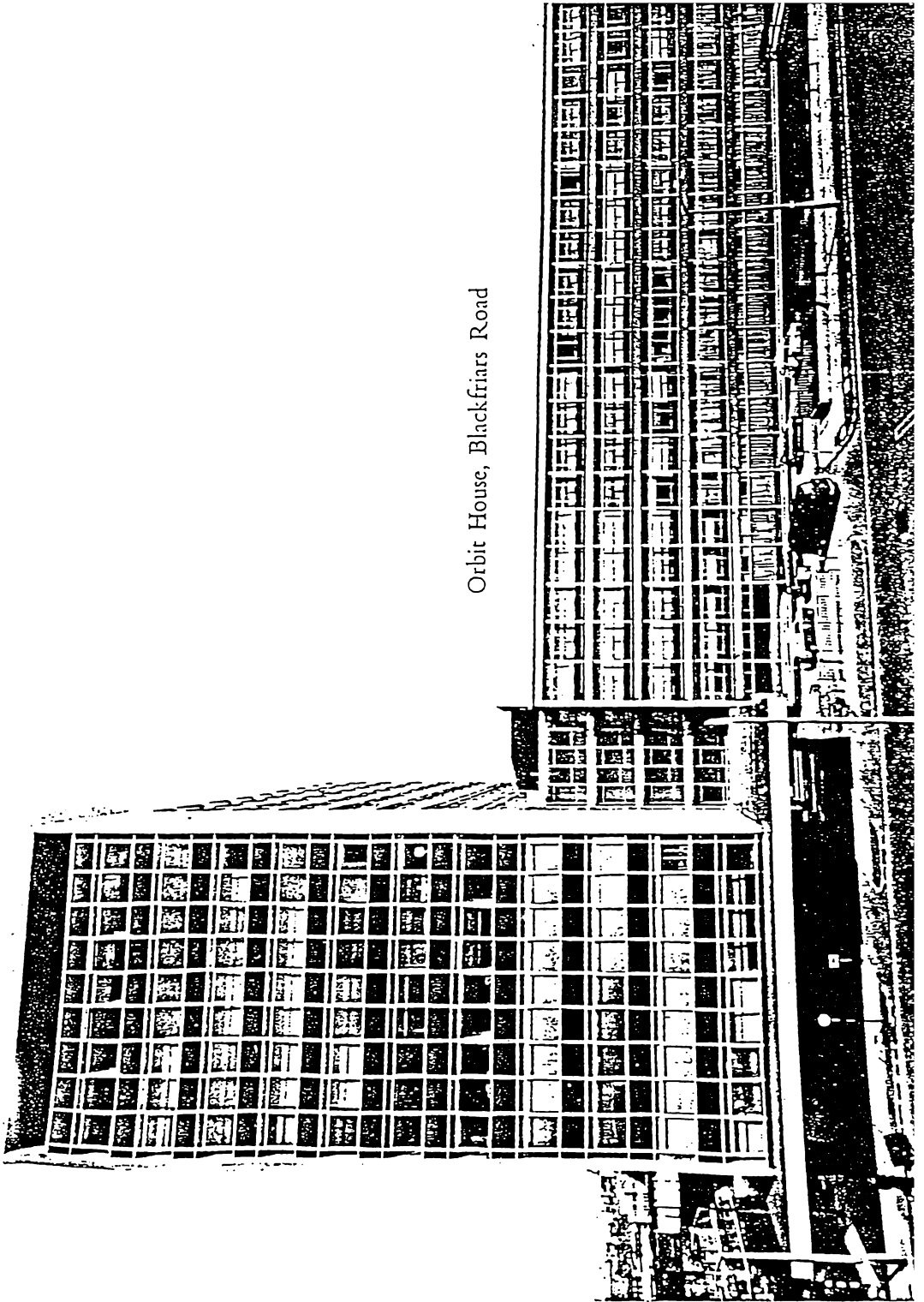

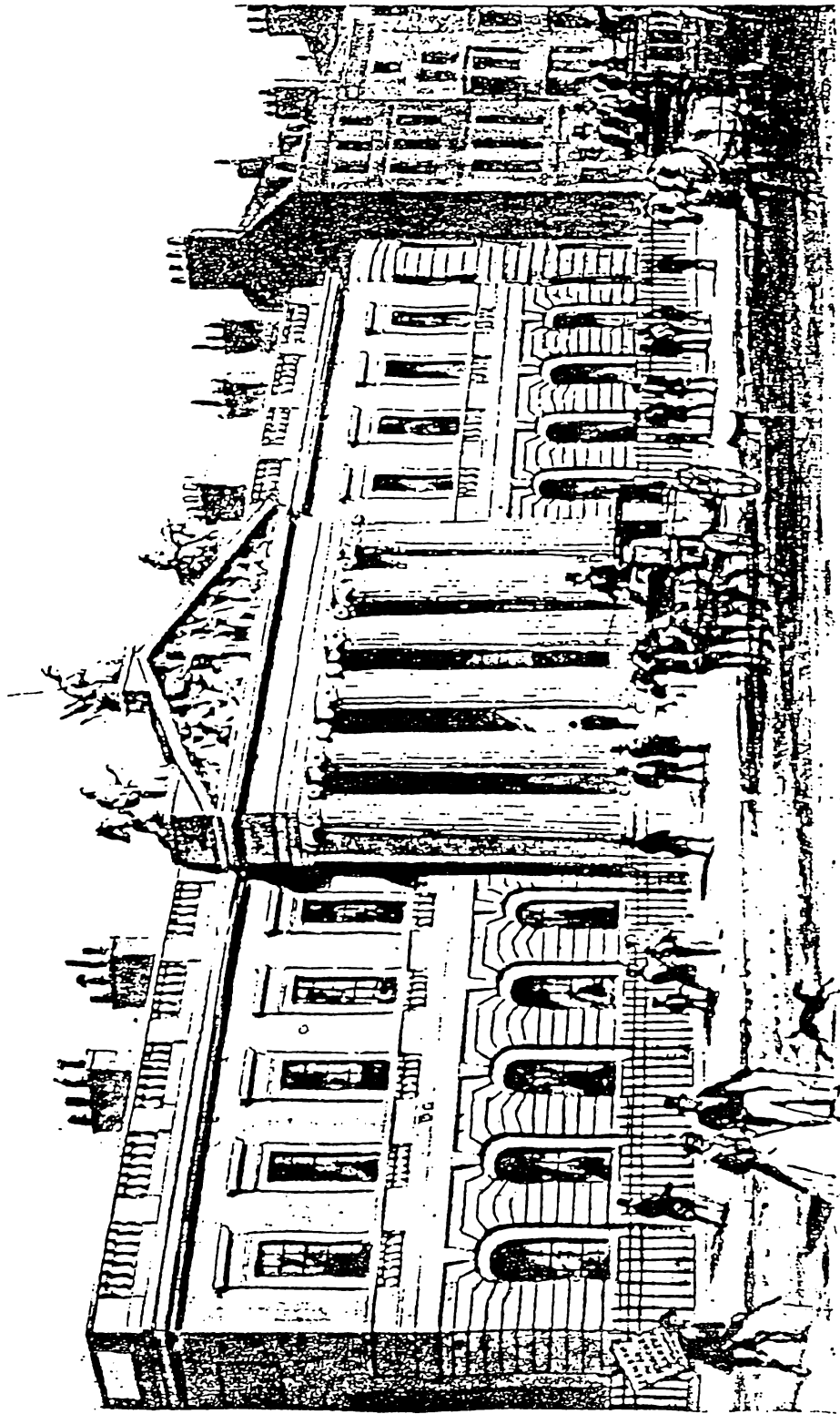

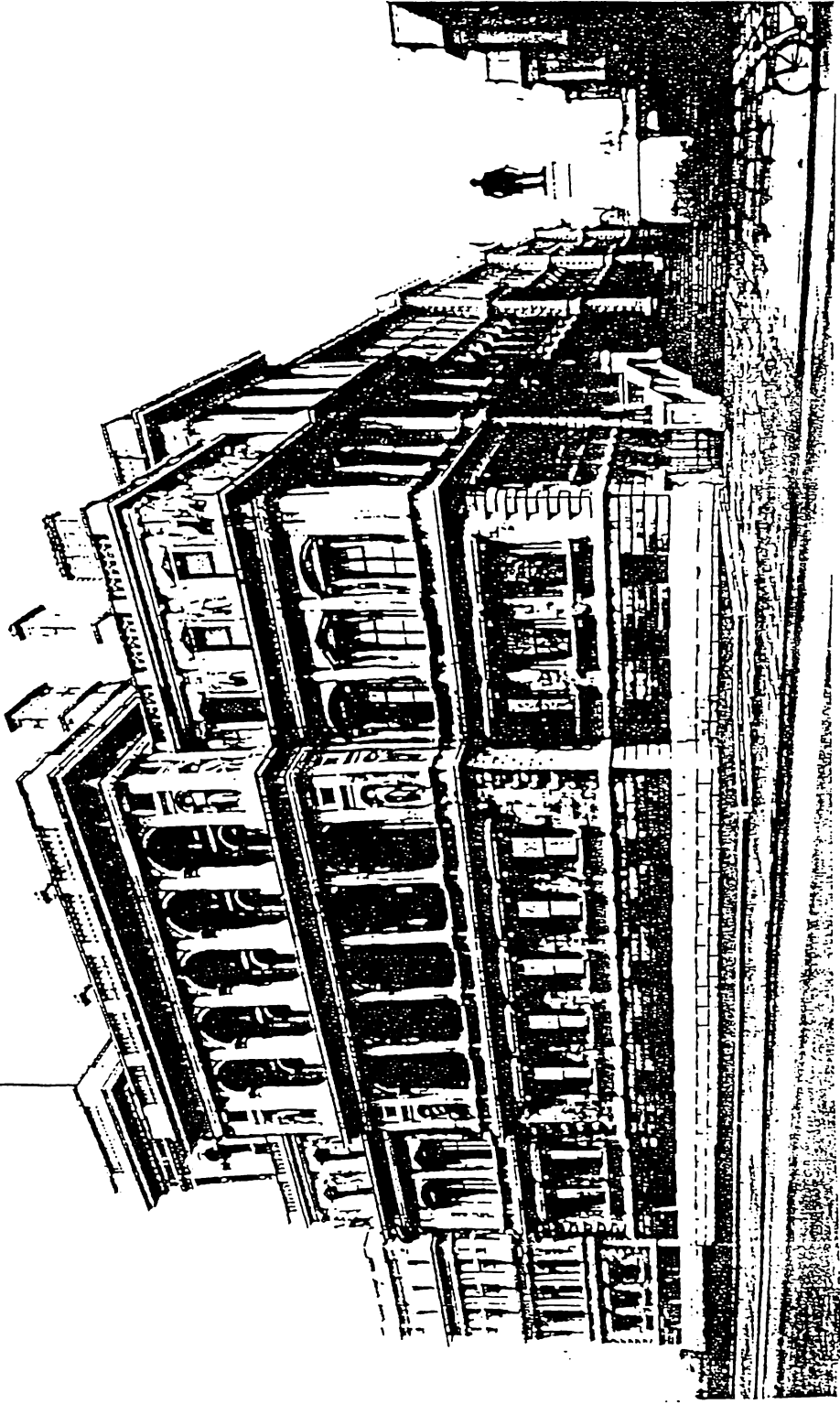
