Item No.1: To confirm the minutes of the Thirty-Third meeting of the Finance Committee held on March 13, 1987

The minutes of the meeting held on 13th March, 1987 were confirmed.

Item No.2: To consider the Draft Manual of Accounts of IIAS

Before taking up the draft Manual for discussion, the Committee examined the schedule of powers attached to the draft Manual with reference to the statement placed on the table containing the existing powers vested in the Director and the erstwhile Registrar (presently Secretary Administration and Finance) of the Institute and decided upon a number of changes. They desired that the schedule of powers should be re-typed after incorporating the necessary changes and sent to the members of the Committee for confirmation before it is included in the Manual.

The Committee approved the draft Manual with the proviso that suitable amendments should be carried out in the chapters dealing with delegation/exercise of powers by the Director and various officers of the Institute, so that there is no conflict between the provisions of the Manual and the Schedule; also that a comparison be made with the corresponding provisions in the D.F.T. Rules. Further, an omnibus clause should be added to the schedule of powers to the effect that the exercise of powers by the two Secretaries and the Librarian will be subject to the overall supervision and control of the Director.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
