Education in the State (in Plan and

1956-57 to 1974-75

The growth of School Education in the State since the formation of the State in 1956-57 can be very clearly seen from the phenomenal increase in the number of institutions established by different managements at the primary as well as the secondary stage of education for providing more educational opportunities to all section of the society. There is substantial increase in (i) the enrolment of children of the age-group 6-11 in the schools in pursuance of the constitutional directive and (ii) the strength of teacher in the educational institutions. ## Primary Stage:

At the primary level, the number of Primary Schools which were only 29,076 in 1956-57 (the first year of the second five-year plan) increased to 36,895 by 1974-75 (the first year of the fifth five-year plan) resulting in a growth of 21.3%. The enrolment of children in schools registered an increase of 28.3% (Boys 18.8% and Girls 4.4%) and the number of teachers working in the schools registered an increase of 3.9%. The enrolment of children of Scheduled Castes in Primary Schools has remarkably increased by 28.5% from 1960-61 to 1973-74 and in the case of children of Scheduled Tribes, the enrolment has almost doubled with an increase of 93.2% during the period.

# Upper Primary Stage:

There is a phenomenal increase in the number of upper primary schools in the State between the period 1956-57 to 1974-75. The number of these schools which was 329 in 1956-57 gradually rose to 3,702 by 1974-75 thus registering a growth of 1,025.2%. There is a corresponding increase in enrolment of children and the number of teachers working in these schools.

# Secondary Stage:

The vast expansion of secondary education is evidenced by the increase of the number of secondary schools from




733 in 1956-57 to 3,276 in 1974-75 thus registering a growth of 346.9%. There is a corresponding increase in the enrolment of children and the number of teachers working in these schools.

The total expenditure on Primary and Secondary Education in the State (in Plan and Non-Plan Schemes) has substantially increased by 70.09% and 47.1% respectively, during 1956-57 to 1974-75.

Higher Education . Management Installed to bodild her

It can be said that there is a rapid expansion in higher education in the State ever since its formation in 1956-57. The number of Degree Colleges offering general education increased from 55 in 1956-57 to 213 by 1974-75 resulting in a growth of 287.1%. The student enrolment in these institutions has increased by 315.4% during the period 1956-57 to 1974-75.

The adoption of 10 plus 2 plus 3 years pattern of education in the State resulted in the establishment of Junior Colleges offering the two year Intermediate Course. The number of these institutions which was 170 in 1969-70 has steadily increased to 258 by 1974-75 registering an increase of 51.70%. Student enrolment in these institutions has increased very much by 483.2% during 1969-70 to 1974-75.
